- Registered** - for an adult keeping bees at any time during the membership year.
- Partner** - for an adult keeping their own bees during the membership year who lives at the same address as the Registered Member shown on this application.
- Country** - for an adult **non**-beekeeper who wishes to to also join the BBKA.
- Family** - for an adult **non**-beekeeper living at the same address as the Registered Member shown on this application.
- Junior** - for a young person under 16 years old on 1/1/2021 who is the child, grandchild or under the care of the Registered or Partner Member shown on this application, covering membership of NF&DBKA only.
- Associate** - for an individual joining NF&DBKA for the first time in the membership year who will not be keeping bees until the 2021/2022 membership year.
- or** a former beekeeping member who will not be keeping bees during the membership year.
- or** a beekeeper covered by Bee Disease Insurance Ltd. through membership of another beekeeping organisation affiliated to the British Beekeepers Association.

The membership fee for a Registered Member comprises a subscription to NF&DBKA £11.00, British Beekeepers' Association capitation £21.00, Hampshire Beekeepers' Association capitation £5.00 this year and a compulsory minimum Bee Disease Insurance Ltd. premium of £2.00.

It is a condition of membership that individuals who are beekeepers, or those intending to keep bees at any time during the membership year, must be covered with Bee Disease Insurance either as a Registered or Partner member of NF&DBKA, another BBKA affiliated association or BDI scheme 'B'.

All bee colonies, including nucleus hives and those situated on communal sites, must be included for Bee Disease Insurance cover to be effective. Bee Disease Insurance Ltd. cover will not commence until 40 days have elapsed from the payment of the premium unless payment is made before 31/3/2022.
